Dear Parents and Carers

During the spring term, your child will be having both their Forest School and cookery lessons on the following day:

On this day, your child will be making apple crumble and therefore will need to bring in the following ingredients:

- 2 large cooking apples, eating apples or pears
- 50g margarine OR butter
- 100g plain flour
- 50g oats
- 50g demerara OR caster sugar
- 5ml spoon cinnamon (optional)

Children should bring the ingredients in a named bag to their classroom in the morning. The school will provide the foil containers to bake the crumbles and transport them home so please do not send your child with a dish. If your child has a clean apron, that they may like to wear, please bring it along too.

For safety reasons and time constraints, we will not be baking the crumble at school. However, instructions will be sent home with your child on how to bake them.

On this day, please also ensure that they bring a bag containing suitable clothing for their Forest School session: **wellies, a waterproof coat and hats/gloves if necessary.**
