Dear Parents and Carers

This year our annual sports day will be held on **Monday 6th July** with a round robin of activities taking place in the morning before individual year group races in the afternoon. In the morning, all children will compete in their houses and take part in six different sporting activities including: archery, nerf throw, hurdles, long jump, bean bag throw and a hockey dribble where all children will contribute valuable points for their houses.

Children will be required to arrive at school in their PE kit for the day's activities and have been asked to wear the colours to represent their house. Children should know which house they are in and the colours are as follows:

- Gresley – yellow
- Pereduras – blue
- Moors – green
- Keepers – red

In the afternoon, children in Year 3 and 4 will take part in: a sprint race, a sack race and an egg and spoon race and the children in Year 5 and 6 will take part in: a sprint race, a skipping race and an egg and spoon race. The relay race will be run by a child who has been selected from each year group and house to compete. As always, we welcome parents, carers and family members to watch and cheer on the children in their afternoon events which will take place from 1.00pm. We would like to invite you, if possible, to wear the colours of your child's house, too. We will have music to enjoy and chairs will be set out along the side of the track. Please note that we only have a limited number of chairs so please feel free to bring your own blanket or seat. As well as this, it is important to mention that the start line will be from the end near the trim trail. Please can you avoid sitting over the finish line.

In the event of a warm, sunny day, please ensure that your child comes to school with a sunhat, sun cream and a water bottle to stay hydrated. In the event of bad weather, sports day will be postponed and a Arbor in-app message will be sent out to all parents.
